Lorissa Learning Lab Hazardous Protection Plan

Lorissa Learning Lab LLC Hazardous Protection plan is always implemented to ensure that all children are safe and healthy during their time at the childcare facility. Listed below are precautions taken so that children remain safe while in attendance:

Children are supervised at all times when leaving the daycare home while crossing the street or intersections there is always one adult/two children ratio. If an accident should occur, and a child needs immediate medical care, 911 will be called and the child(ren) will be taken to the nearest emergency room, and their parent will be called. Should there be traffic construction and parents cannot get down my street, they drive through the alley and come in the back door. They can also park their car on another block and walk their child to the daycare in the case that the street is block of due to construction.

There is no pool at the daycare home. If there is standing water from the rain children are not allowed around and it is removed promptly. Children are always supervised by the Provider, Substitute and/or Assistants.

Children are not allowed to run in the daycare home and are reminded to always use their walking feet to prevent falling or slipping.

After checking the backyard for any debris, the children are allowed to run and play. There is a fence around the yard securing the children from any outside hazards, including stray dogs and strangers. The yard is well maintained, and the children are always supervised by an adult.

All cleaning supplies are put away in locked cabinets, behind locked doors or placed high enough so they are out of all children's reach.

The daycare home is cleaned and sanitized on a daily basis.

Should anything happen to my staff or myself, parents will be called and asked to pick their children up immediately.

Open stairwells are always blocked with protective gates when children 5 and younger are present. Should any child get hurt on the stairs, the parent will be called, and an incident report will be completed and given to the parent.

Should anything happen to the Provider, parents will be notified immediately to pick their children up, the Substitute will assist with the children until all parents have picked up their children.
